Introduction

A recent initiative of the New Zealand Companion Animal Council has been the establishment of the New Zealand Companion Animal Register. The purpose of the register is to provide an identification and retrieval system for all companion animals microchipped and registered in New Zealand.

The register is operated under a trust involving the following principal stakeholders:

- New Zealand Veterinary Association,
- NZVA Companion Animal Society,
- New Zealand Kennel Club,
- New Zealand Cat Fancy Association,
- SPCA, and
- New Zealand Companion Animal Council.

The register is designed to provide instant access to comprehensive information that will assist in the reuniting of animals with their owners/guardians.

Under the established Trust, profits derived from the register will be allocated on application, and at the discretion of the Trustees, to provide ongoing animal welfare services through out New Zealand.

National Dog Database

The current compulsory microchipping of dogs and adding to the National Dog Database does not provide an acceptable and universal retrieval mechanism for lost pets, nor was it designed for this purpose.

The Key Facts

- The one-off cost of registering is \$15 (inclusive of GST) for the life of the animal.
- Each Vet Clinic or Vet will be invoiced monthly for new registrations added in the previous month.
- The Register is supported by the leading companion animal organisations in New Zealand.
- All profits from this register will be used to support companion animal welfare charities in New Zealand.
- The Register is a New Zealand based and operated system.
- The Register can hold animal identification, medical notes, primary contact, emergency contact and breeder details.
