The difference between the NZ Companion Animal Register and Local Council registration

NZ Companion Animal Register



Is voluntary

Is *for animal guardians* to use as a lost and found platform – helping lost pets get home quickly (including LostPet platform)

Can be used for **ALL** species of animals

Accessible by **950+** vet clinics, SPCA, shelters, and Animal Control

Minimal, one-off fee to our charity – revenue goes to animal welfare

How to register:

- Directly online or through your vet
- SPCA registers ALL cats & dogs
- Shelters & breeders often register.

Local Council Registration



Is a legal requirement

Is *for councils* to use to maintain record of all dogs and their owners details, and reunite locally via animal control officers

Only for dogs

Accessible by council staff (e.g. animal control officers, council shelters)

Annual fee for council dog registration

Register with your local Council online or in person.
